Analyzing Spoken Language Skills

Here is an example of a simple “ProofListening” checklist that plays off of the proofreading checklists often used to review writing. This can be used to review a student’s audio- or video-recording. The components in the checklist should align with the student’s goals specific to language parameters (phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, pragmatics/discourse).

ProofLISTENING Checklist

- Used the correct verb tense
- Produced compound sentence
Used the conjunction _____
- Used new vocabulary (list two words used)

- Ideas are correctly sequenced
- Narrative included at least two supporting details
