Pre-Lesson Assessment	Post-Lesson Assessment and Progress Monitoring Tools	
<ul> <li>Pre-tests: Designed for students to take before a new unit / new school year to discover what students know or don't know in a particular topic.</li> <li>Free-write: Students write on a topic of their choice as a way to determine student's writing skills</li> <li>K.W.L charts: Stands for "Knows, Wants to Know, and Learned and can assess student's background knowledge and interest on a given topic.</li> <li>Analysis of student work: Teachers can look at different types of assignments (tests, essays, journals, notes etc) and assess what students understand and/or don't know.</li> <li>Interviews or checklists about learning behaviors: Teachers design questions or likert scales to determine student's understanding of their own learning</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Targeted data collection on specific skills: Repeat a free-write assignment or a math test to gauge progress from the first attempt</li> <li>Exit tickets: This asks students to provide a synthesis of an aspect of the day's lesson</li> <li>Concept Map: Have students draw or visually represent their understanding or a concept</li> <li>Journaling: Have students self-reflect about their progress</li> <li>Roll the Dice: Each student gets a dice and based on the number rolled they ca fill-in-the-blank for the below statements</li> <li>I want to remember</li> <li>Something I learned today</li> <li>One word to sum up what I learned</li> <li>Something I already knew</li> <li>I'm still confused about</li> </ul>
