**Proofreading practice: Capitalization** 

Always make sure to capitalize:

- the pronoun "I"
- the first letter of a new sentence
- proper nouns (names)
- state abbreviations

**Directions:** Change each incorrectly used lowercase letter to a capital letter. The number at the end tells how many corrections you need to make.

**EXAMPLE:** M B F
