FREE LANGUAGE-BASED TEACHING STRATEGIES

Tic-Tac-Toe

This versatile strategy based on the common logic game can be used to help students hone their spelling, reading, and/or vocabulary skills

Materials needed:

- 1. Dice
- 2. Tic-Tac-Toe board
- 3. Reading, spelling, or vocabulary lists

Setup:

- 1. Fill the board with target words
 - a. To practice reading, fill the 9 square board with target words
 - b. For spelling, fill the 9 square board with target words and cover squares to test spelling
 - c. Boards could be filled with a combination of both covered and uncovered squares
- 2. Define the directions for all 6 numbers on the dice. Possible directions:
 - a. Syllabicate and read the word
 - b. Spell the word
 - c. Identify the root of the word
 - d. Identify the prefix of the word
 - e. Define the word
 - f. Use the word in a sentence

Directions

- 1. Students work in pairs or in teams (one team is the X and the other team is the O)
- 2. Teams decide space they want to win
- 3. Teams roll the dice to determine task
- 4. Tasks correctly answered win squares on the board
- 5. To win-- three Xs in a row or three Os in a row



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
